2018 Halloween Costume Guidelines

Halloween costumes are permitted to be worn to school Wednesday 10/31. Below are the guidelines administration has set to ensure everyone has a safe and fun day. You may choose to dress in costume if you'd like, otherwise regular SA uniform is required.

1. No masks, no hoods or anything that covers your face. Why? Because we need to be able to recognize you immediately as someone permitted in the building (for safety reasons).
 2. No full-face make up (same reason as #1).
 3. No weapons of any kind, sharp objects or props are permitted. Again, safety reasons.
 4. No inappropriate logos or sayings (this includes politics).
 5. Costumes must be culturally sensitive.
 6. No lingerie.
 7. No inflatable costumes
 8. Normal dress down rules apply: no flip flops, no mesh or see-through clothing, no ripped jeans, and shorts and skirts must be an appropriate length.
