Writing: Today, students practiced using “good vs. well” in grammar. They worked in journals and we shared entries. Students then used a mentor text to complete a writing assignment in journals.

Reading: edited and evaluated claims and evidence; worked through A & B in class.

HW: complete C on p. 63 (use 62 if you need more space)(Period 2 students only need to identify and support tone for the first paragraph), work on simile/metaphor log;

Math: Today the graded quiz was returned to students and we reviewed the “pitfall of graphing” - notes/reminders are in skinny notebook. Then we worked with a partner on “In the Doghouse” performance task. This will be in-class work, so Mrs. C. collected papers.
