Message from our Head of School

Dear Sussex Academy Community,

Last week our faculty and staff returned to kick-off the first of two weeks of professional development and if I could only use one word to describe the collective energy that started the week, that word would be "inspiring." Along with many of our veteran faculty and staff returning, we have many accomplished educators new to the SA community, who bring the experience and passion necessary to continue to provide the most exceptional academic experience in Sussex County and the State of Delaware. Just like the rest of the world, Sussex Academy felt the negative impacts of existing through a global pandemic, however, I am proud to say that despite the rest of the state seeing significant declines in academic performance, not only did the students at Sussex Academy not see significant declines in their academic performance, but comparatively improved the schools overall academic standing, outperforming all other districts and charters in several state testing categories. 
