## SCHOOL PROFILE 2022-2023

Sussex Academy originated as Sussex Academy of Arts and Sciences in 2000 serving grades 6-8. In 2013, the school name was changed to Sussex Academy, and grade 9 was first enrolled. With steady enrollment growth each year since, we have since graduated 6 classes.

Sussex Academy is located in rural southern Delaware and is the only operating charter school in Sussex County. Admission is by lottery.

\*Students at Sussex Academy may have the opportunity to participate in The Academic Challenge (AC) Program. AC was established in 1987 as a college-school partnership between the nine Sussex County School Districts and the Georgetown Campus of Delaware Tech. Qualified students are identified in seventh grade for the five-year program which offers the standard high school curriculum in mathematics and English at an accelerated pace allowing for college coursework during the junior and senior years of high school. All college courses are taught at the Georgetown Campus through Delaware Tech. It is possible to earn 12 college credits in English and 15 college credits in mathematics.

- 188 total IB exams administered in May 2022
- Of the 18 IB Diploma Candidates, 15 were awarded the IB Diploma
- IB Literature HL average score = 4.9
- IB Spanish average score = 4.8 (SL); 6.2 (HL)
- IB Math Analysis average score = 3.9 (SL); 3.0 (HL)
- IB History HL average score = 4.8
- IB Chemistry SL average score = 4.1
- IB Design Tech SL average score = 5.2
